Why a career in diesel technology?

Begin your career in a high-demand diesel industry with a Diesel Technology Certificate. As a diesel technician, you will work with innovative technology, electrical and electronic equipment, maintain and repair vehicles and operate industrial machinery. Through training in our hands-on lab, you'll learn how to assist installations, maintenance, and repair workers.

What is my earning potential?

A starting wage for students graduating with this certificate are between \$14.00 and \$18.00 an hour. For students looking to continue through the Diesel Technology Program, the average starting salaries are between \$43,000 and \$46,000 a year after graduation. After five years in the industry, salaries are between \$56,000 and \$62,000* a year.

What are my possible career pathways?

Graduates could enjoy a career as a technician assistant, equipment assembler, service writer, or a parts sales person. Students interested in continuing through our Diesel Technology Program could pursue a career maintaining diesel engine equipment in automobiles, buses, ships, heavy trucks, railroad locomotives, stationary diesel generators, and construction equipment.
